

R.B.Hall Memorial Band

The R.B.Hall Band was organized in 1969 as a summer recreation project of the Waterville Parks and Recreation Program with the intention of perpetuating the memory of composer Robert Browne Hall and his music. Today, in the true tradition of community bands, our performers come from all over the state, and are required only to have fun,



maintain friendships, and be willing to travel with a horn! We have the honor of being the only band in Maine that is allowed to borrow Mr. Hall's personal and antique cornet from the Redington Museum in Waterville for special occasions.

Although the band was originally conceived as a marching band (in the spirit of city and military bands) we now "sit to play" in many different venues ranging from flatbed trailers in parades to band parking lots. We perform annually on the lawn at the Redington Museum in Waterville, at the Lion's Club Fair in Clinton, and—for the price of "sundaes all 'round—for the annual Oakland Historical Society Ice Cream Socials. Because we especially love to perform in gazebos, we frequently play in town parks on Tuesday nights in lieu of our regular rehearsals with no fee attached.

Our band maintains a mailing roster of about 40 musicians from all walks of life, levels of musicianship, ages, and place — we have several regular visitors "from away", and even a cello player who sits in with the trombones when he's in town. We are directed by Brian Hutchinson and Dennis Harrington. We rehearse every Tuesday night in the summer at Colleen's and Dennis' home on West School Street in Oakland at 7:00—8:30 p.m. (Our winter rehearsal schedules vary depending up on the weather.) Any and all musicians are invited and welcome to join us—we play to have fun!
